Admission Policy

The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences

Objective

To define and implement transparent, merit-based admission rules and ensure fair selection of students at The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

Scope

This policy is applicable to all applicants seeking admission in academic programs offered by The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

1. Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility

All applicants must meet the academic requirements prescribed by the relevant regulatory authority and admission standards of The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

Applicants must:



- Possess required previous academic qualification.
- Meet minimum percentage criteria as announced in prospectus.
- Fulfill age and health requirements where applicable.

2. Application Process

Submission of Application

Applicants must submit a completed admission form along with required documents before the announced deadline.

Required documents include:

- Attested copies of academic certificates
- CNIC/Form-B copy
- Domicile (if required)
- Recent passport-size photographs

Incomplete applications will not be processed.

3. Entry Test and Interview

Assessment

Applicants may be required to appear in an entry test and/or interview as determined by The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

Merit Evaluation

Final merit will be calculated based on academic record, entry test performance, and interview (if applicable).

4. Merit List

Publication

Merit lists will be displayed on the official notice board and/or website of The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

Selection

Admissions will be granted strictly according to merit and available seats.



5. Fee Submission

Confirmation of Admission

Selected candidates must submit prescribed admission and tuition fee within the given deadline.

Failure to deposit fee within due date may result in cancellation of admission offer.

6. Verification of Documents

All selected candidates must present original documents for verification at the time of admission confirmation.

If any document is found fake or misleading, admission shall be cancelled immediately.

7. Migration / Transfer

Transfer or migration cases will only be considered as per regulatory authority rules and subject to seat availability.

8. Cancellation of Admission

The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences reserves the right to cancel admission if:

- False information is provided
- Required documents are not submitted
- Fee is not paid within due date
- Student violates institutional rules

9. Deferment Policy

Admission deferment requests may be considered only under exceptional circumstances and with approval of competent authority.
