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Clinical Training Policy

The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences

Objective

To provide structured clinical training to students, ensuring practical skill development, patient care experience, and adherence to professional standards.

Scope

This policy applies to all students enrolled in nursing and health sciences programs at The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

1. Clinical Training Affiliation

- The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences has signed a **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)** with **Afridi Medical Center** to provide clinical training opportunities.
- All clinical rotations, practical training, and hospital exposure will be conducted at Afridi Medical Center under this agreement.

2. Duration and Schedule

- Clinical training is mandatory for all students as per program curriculum.
- Schedule will include specified hours in wards, laboratories, and patient care areas.
- Attendance will be monitored daily and recorded in the college attendance system.



3. Supervision and Evaluation

- Students will be supervised by qualified clinical instructors and hospital staff.
- Clinical performance will be evaluated regularly through practical assessments, logbooks, and feedback forms.
- Evaluation will contribute to final grades and eligibility for promotion.

4. Student Responsibilities

- Maintain professional behavior and ethical conduct during clinical rotations.
- Follow all hospital rules, patient confidentiality, and infection control protocols.
- Wear official uniform and identification badge at all times.
- Report to assigned supervisors for instructions and feedback.
