**Examination & Promotion Policy**

The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences

**Objective**

To establish clear guidelines for student assessments, examinations, and promotion criteria, ensuring academic standards and fairness.

**Scope**

This policy applies to all students enrolled in programs at The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

**1. Assessment Methods**

Students will be evaluated using a combination of:

- **Internal assessments** (class tests, assignments, quizzes)
- **Practical/clinical evaluations**
- **Final examinations** (theory and practical)

Assessment weightage will be communicated at the start of each academic session.

**2. Passing Criteria**

- Students must achieve **minimum passing marks** as defined by the regulatory authority and The Scholars College of Nursing and Health Sciences.



- Separate passing in theory and practical components may be required, depending on program requirements.

### 3. Examination Schedule

- Examination schedule will be published at the beginning of each semester/year.
- Students are responsible for appearing on scheduled dates.
- Any changes will be communicated in advance via notice or email.

### 4. Re-Appear / Supplementary Policy

- Students who fail any subject may be allowed to **reappear** in supplementary examinations.
- Re-examination must be completed within the academic session as per college schedule.
- Re-appear applications must be submitted within the specified deadline.

### 5. Promotion Criteria

- Promotion to the next academic year requires passing all **required subjects**.
- Students failing multiple subjects may be required to **repeat the year**.
- Attendance and academic performance both contribute to eligibility for promotion.

### 6. Examination Misconduct

- Cheating or any unethical conduct during examinations will be dealt with under **disciplinary action**, which may include expulsion.
- Faculty and examination committee will monitor and report misconduct.

### 7. Result Declaration

- Results will be declared within a reasonable time after examinations.
- Students can access results through the official notice board or website.
